Position Summary:

Provides assessment, counseling, information and referral, advocacy services, and other resource assistance to patients either directly or through consultation.

Responsibilities:

1. Develop and Update written protocols for the delivery of psychosocial support services
2. Provides staff development and training on assessment, re-assessment, care plans, interventions, prioritizing needs and follow up.
3. Provides complete psychosocial assessments of patients and families.
4. Provides counseling to individuals and families to help solve social and emotional problems.
5. Coordinates community resources to address/meet identified needs of a varied patient population.
6. Assists families in adapting to difficult and complicated dispositions involving complex/catastrophic care needs, multiple agencies/providers and linkage to resources outside the community.
7. Provides consultation, assessment, referral and coordination in cases of suspected child or dependent adult abuse or neglect, or other forms of domestic violence.
8. Organizes support groups; Participates in the RCGN Cancer Support groups along with the nursing staff
9. Provides consultation and technical assistance to the provider and staff about individual clients psychosocial needs
10. Acts as the clients advocate in procuring local, state and federal benefits and services which he/she is entitled to receive.
11. Documents appropriate objective, concise and pertinent clinical data in the medical record.
12. Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- ✓ Master's Degree in Social Work (MSW) required.
- ✓ Social work experience in an acute, home care, or ambulatory setting preferred.
- ✓ Strong organizational skills.
- ✓ Good verbal and written communications skills.
- ✓ Sound decision making and judgment.
- ✓ Time management skills.
- ✓ Negotiation skills.
- ✓ Proven ability to deal with conflict resolution.
- ✓ Comfortable with basic computer skills.
